# A Statement from the National Episcopal Cursillo



## A Statement from the National Episcopal Cursillo, May 2008

Cursillo has always kept its eyes firmly focused on Jesus and on the Mission. One of the principles of the Cursillo movement is that: **We focus on Christ and His resurrection power in our lives, transforming us into the people He would have us be. Theological disputes and political issues have no part in our agenda.**

The Cursillo Movement is a movement that brings together all people, whether they might consider themselves to have a liberal or conservative Christian philosophy or somewhere in between, for the common good of promoting Jesus Christ and God's Mission. It is Christ-centered and Christ-focused. The Policy of the National Episcopal Cursillo Committee is that it will not be an organization with a political or social agenda. National Episcopal Cursillo is a movement of the Episcopal Church.

We recognize, however, that a number of individuals with connections and interest in the Episcopal Cursillo Movement are no longer affiliated with the Episcopal Church. As a sign of reconciliation, we welcome those still able, as individuals, to be in communion with the local Episcopal Diocesan Bishop and fellow Cursillistas, whether lay or ordained, to participate in the activities of the Cursillo Movement. Furthermore, and always at the Diocesan Bishop's discretion, we encourage an openness to their continued participation and interest in the activities of the Episcopal Cursillo. It should be understood by all that as a part of their participation, they agree to do so fully for the advancement of Cursillo, be supportive of the mission of Episcopal Cursillo, and agree that they will not promote any political agenda.

What is clear is that National Episcopal Cursillo was created to serve the Episcopal Church in the United States, and we are licensed by the Roman Catholic Church to do that. Despite our personal theological and political views, we are focused on knowing Christ and making Him known to others. That is our call and in doing it lays our greatest joy. Ultreya! Ultreya!! Let us get on with the day's apostolic action. Let us all pray for the Church and one another everyday.



# 2014 State of Cursillo

In the past year, the Secretariat has been relentless in developing the best programs for all of our Cursillistas and future weekends.

- ◆ There were two weekends, with a total of about 20 candidates.
- ◆ The Secretariat re-established position descriptions for all Secretariat and Servant Community positions.
- ◆ The parish list for Area Reps was updated.
- ◆ The Cursillo brochure was mailed to all non-participating Parishes.
- ◆ We voted to continue the Joy of Giving Talk on weekends and at fourth day workshops.
- ◆ We decided to keep the current policy of allowing new Cursillistas to serve on a team after 6 months.
- ◆ The number of Team Members required on a team was lowered from 21 to 15 (additional members may be added when needed).
- ◆ The MEC community Assisted at the Consecration service for Bishop Cook and donated \$250.00 to the Bishop's consecration gift.
- ◆ MD 107 will be using the Inn this November.
- ◆ MD 108 (the April Weekend) will be a mission weekend for Inner-city Parishes in Baltimore. Carol Gooden will be the Rector.
- ◆ Ultreyas are down, and the Secretariat will start holding Ultreyas in areas not currently active. Western MD will be the first one scheduled.
- ◆ Area Rep positions are open in Southern and Central Maryland.
- ◆ All are reminded that if you want to serve on a team you must submit a new application. Applications are not held for more than 2 years and not kept on file after you serve on a team.
- ◆ As a reminder the Secretariat meets the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of the month at Christ the King, Woodlawn, at 10 a.m. All Cursillistas are invited to attend.

## Apostolic Action at Any Age - 97 Years Young!

Ruth Virginia Sweeting Walkes is a firm believer that life does not stop because you get older. She is a living example of what the Cursillo Movement hopes to develop in all our leaders. Ruth is a lifetime member of Christ Church, Coconut Grove, Florida, where she was baptized and confirmed. Before becoming a Cursillista, Ruth served in many areas of the Parish. She was a member of the Altar Guild for 57 years.

In 1983, Father Ron Fox sponsored her on a Cursillo Weekend. Her Weekend was Episcopal Women’s Cursillo #36 where she sat at the table of St. Bernadette. She says that her weekend was a turning point in her life. After returning from the weekend she began to make soup out of her own kitchen for the sick and shut-in who lived in her community. This ministry grew as others heard about Mrs. Ruth’s soup. She continued this ministry for many years until she could no longer drive. Since then, she has embarked on another ministry. She crochets prayer shawls for young women in her Parish who are graduating from high school. She even allows them to select the color of their specially made shawl. She has also made shawls for the sick and shut-ins at her church.

Another of her ministries involved her sponsorship of candidates from her church. In 2006 she became the South Sector caller for the movement and continues this ministry until today.

What can you say about a special woman like Ruth Walkes. She turned 97 years old on December 1, 2013 and is still such a vibrant part of each Cursillo weekend. She comes out to the Send-offs and can be seen at many of the Serenades.

Ruth says that to date, Cursillo has been her life! She enjoys following a rule of life which is guided by the Holy Spirit, and she has been strengthened in her journey by her faith and her Apostolic Action. She is truly an incredible, loving, serving, servant of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

*"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." — Romans 12:2*

These words, written by the Apostle Paul to the church in Rome, are one of the greatest passages in scripture. **A Cursillista (Lay or Clergy) wishing to serve on a Weekend Team should:**

- ✓ Have attended a **4th Day workshop**; and
- ✓ Be active in the **4th Day** by regularly attending Ultreyas, participating in Group Reunion, and supporting and attending Las Mañanitas and Clausura when possible.

### Guidelines for Weekend Team Membership

- Weekend Rectors select team members from Cursillistas who have submitted a [Team Application](#)
- [Applications](#) for serving on a Weekend Team will be valid until such time as the Cursillista has been selected and served on a Cursillo Team, **or** for 3 years, whichever comes first.
- A Cursillista may elect to submit a [new application](#) at any time the information reflected on his/her application changes.
- Currently, the team fee is \$265.00. This covers *only* The Claggett Center room and board.

Cursillistas selected to serve on a Weekend Team should not sponsor a candidate for the same weekend on which they are serving on team. Spouses or fiancées of Cursillo team members should not be a candidate on the same weekend on which the team member is serving on team.


